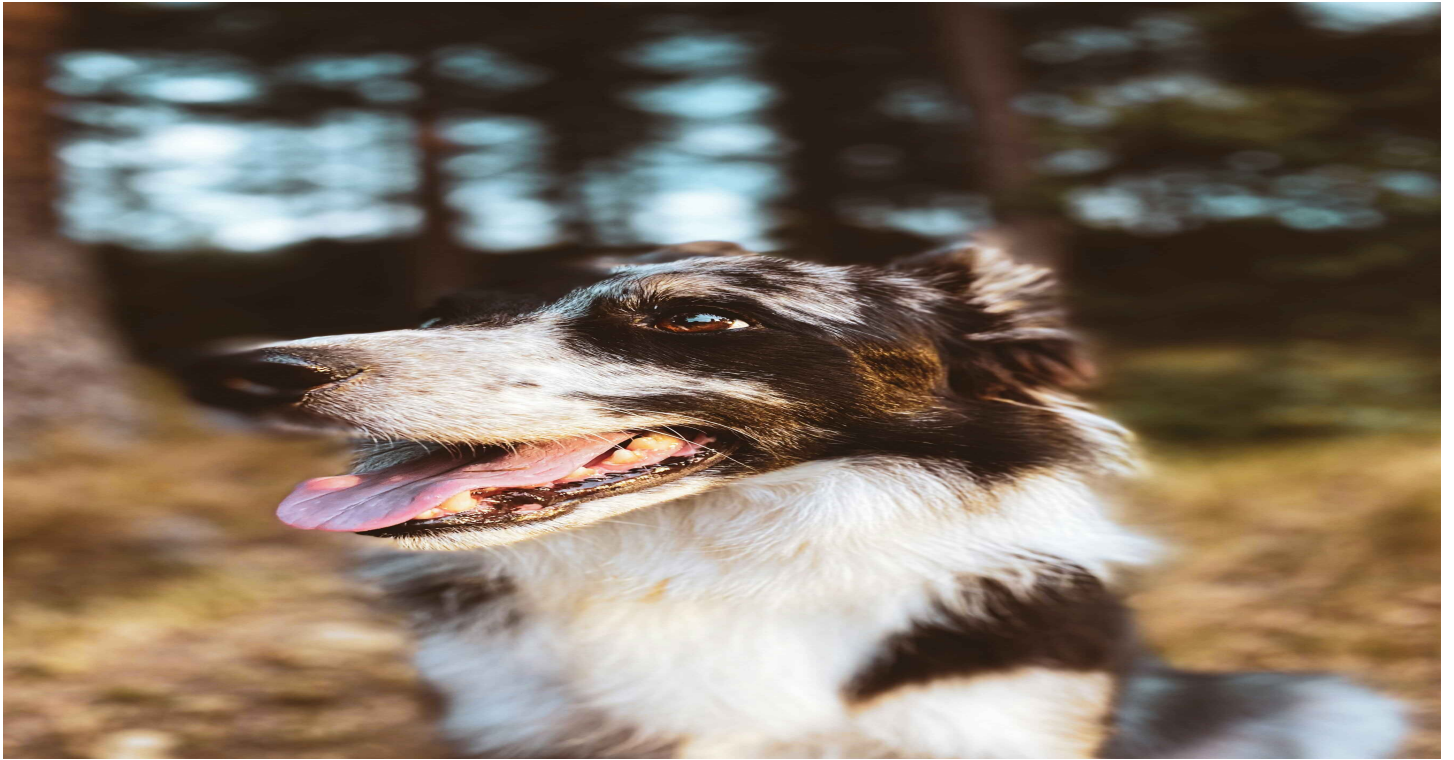




Colonial Charm. Pine Trails. Quiet Lanes. Slow Mountain Days

5 Days / 4 Nights

Route: Delhi -> Panipat -> Ambala -> Kalka -> Dharampur -> Kasauli

WHY KASAULI WORKS FOR PETS

Kasauli is a hill station best discovered on foot and at an unhurried pace.

Its charm lies less in grand sights and more in old colonial paths, pine-covered paths, viewpoints, heritage buildings and quiet corners where you can simply stop and take in the mountains.

For pets, this creates a lovely rhythm.

A morning forest walk.

A slow heritage stroll.

An outdoor coffee break.

An afternoon nap at the resort.

And a sunset somewhere above the valley.

Kasauli is particularly suited to dogs who enjoy walking, sniffing, exploring and being outdoors, while still having the

comfort of a relaxed mountain resort to return to.

PET-FRIENDLY EXPERIENCES

Gilbert Trail

One of Kasauli's most beautiful walking experiences.

A scenic forest trail with pine trees, mountain views and plenty of opportunities to explore at a relaxed pace.

Best for: Dogs who love nature walks and new smells.

Mall Road & Heritage Walk

Explore Kasauli's charming central lanes and colonial-era surroundings.

Keep your pet leashed, particularly around shops and busier stretches.

Best for: Slow walks, architecture, cafés and people-watching.

Sunset Point

A classic Kasauli viewpoint overlooking the surrounding hills.

Best for: Evening walks and sunset photographs with your pet.

Monkey Point

One of Kasauli's best-known viewpoints, offering expansive views from the highest point in the area.

Best for: Panoramic views and a scenic outing.

Pet access and current restrictions should be checked before planning this visit.

Christ Church

A historic landmark in the heart of Kasauli.

Enjoy the architecture and surrounding heritage quarter, while keeping your pet outside any restricted indoor areas.

Kasauli Brewery

A historic landmark and one of the town's distinctive heritage attractions.

Treat this primarily as an architectural/heritage stop rather than a pet activity.

Kasauli Club Surroundings

The old-world character around the club and cantonment adds to the charm of a heritage walk.

Dharampur Countryside

Take a scenic drive down towards Dharampur and explore the quieter countryside surrounding Kasauli.

Best for: A change of scenery and relaxed outdoor time with your pet.

Timber Trail

An optional excursion towards Parwanoo/Dharampur.

The surrounding mountain landscape is beautiful, but access for pets should be checked in advance, particularly for managed attractions.

Resort Time

A property with gardens, lawns or private outdoor spaces can make a huge difference.

For many pets, the quiet afternoon at the resort will be just as memorable as the sightseeing.

GETTING THERE WITH YOUR PET

Distance: Approx. 290–310 km from Delhi

Drive Time: Approximately 6½–8 hours

Recommended Route:

Delhi Panipat Ambala Kalka Dharampur Kasauli

The first part of the journey is primarily highway driving.

The road becomes increasingly winding after Kalka and Dharampur, as you climb into the hills.

Plan a proper break around Ambala or Kalka before beginning the final mountain section.

If your dog is sensitive to winding roads, take the climb slowly and allow additional breaks where practical.

The final climb is where the landscape changes — traffic gives way to pine forests, cooler air and mountain roads.

PET NOTES

- The final approach to Kasauli is winding, so take extra care with pets prone to motion sickness.
- Gilbert Trail and other forest paths can be uneven, rocky or slippery after rain.
- Keep your pet leashed on public roads, heritage lanes, viewpoints and forest trails.
- Kasauli's monkeys are accustomed to visitors; keep dogs close and do not allow them to chase or approach wildlife.
- Viewpoints can have steep drops or exposed edges — supervise pets closely.
- Carry drinking water for longer walks.
- Avoid allowing pets to drink from natural water sources.
- Winter mornings and evenings can be cold, so carry a warm layer for your pet.
- Check paws after forest walks for ticks, thorns, mud and grass seeds.
- Keep the afternoon relatively free for rest, particularly after a longer morning walk.
- Outdoor cafés and public areas may have their own pet-access rules.

SUGGESTED PET-PACED ITINERARY

DAY 1 | DELHI KASAULI

Drive from Delhi towards Kasauli via Panipat, Ambala, Kalka and Dharampur.

Take a proper break before beginning the final mountain climb.

Arrive at the property, check in and allow your pet to settle in.

Evening

Head out for a relaxed walk around Mall Road and the heritage quarter.

Explore the old buildings, quiet lanes and surrounding cantonment atmosphere.

Return to the resort for dinner and a relaxed evening.

The first evening is for stretching your legs, breathing mountain air and discovering Kasauli slowly.

DAY 2 | GILBERT TRAIL • CHRIST CHURCH • MALL ROAD

Start the day early with a relaxed breakfast.

Morning

Take your pet along the Gilbert Trail for a scenic forest walk.

Keep the pace comfortable and allow plenty of time for your dog to explore.

Late Morning

Return towards town and visit Christ Church and the surrounding heritage quarter, keeping your pet outside restricted areas.

Continue with a relaxed walk along Kasauli Mall Road.

Afternoon

Return to the property for lunch and a proper rest.

Evening

Enjoy the resort or take a short neighbourhood walk.

DAY 3 | SUNSET POINT • MONKEY POINT • DHARAMPUR

Morning

Begin with a relaxed outing towards Monkey Point, subject to current access restrictions and pet-entry conditions.

Enjoy the panoramic mountain views and return at an easy pace.

Afternoon

Head towards Dharampur for a scenic countryside drive.

If you prefer a more relaxed day, return directly to the resort and enjoy the property instead.

Evening

Head out to Sunset Point.

Find a comfortable spot, watch the hills change colour and enjoy the evening together.

Today is about the views — not how many viewpoints you manage to tick off.

DAY 4 | SLOW MORNING DELHI

Enjoy a relaxed breakfast.

Take your pet for one final walk around the property.

Check out and begin the descent towards Dharampur and Kalka before continuing towards Delhi.

Take a comfortable break on the highway before completing the journey home.

Leave Kasauli slowly. One last mountain view is always worth five more minutes.

DAY 5 | OPTIONAL EXTRA DAY

For a 4N/5D holiday, keep the fifth day deliberately flexible.

OPTION 1 | COUNTRYSIDE WALK

Spend the morning exploring quieter trails and roads around the property.

OPTION 2 | DHARAMPUR & TIMBER TRAIL

Take a relaxed drive towards Dharampur and consider a Timber Trail excursion, subject to current pet-access

conditions.

OPTION 3 | COMPLETE RESORT DAY

Stay back.

Long breakfast.

Garden time.

A slow afternoon.

Mountain views.

A sunset walk.

Sometimes the extra day is simply permission to stop doing things.

A comfortable 4-star resort in the Dharampur area, offering a more spacious base for exploring Kasauli.

Best for: Families travelling with dogs who want a full-service resort experience.

PREMIUM | PINE VALLEY RESORT

A mountain resort offering a relaxed setting away from the busiest parts of Kasauli.

Outdoor surroundings provide opportunities for relaxed time with pets.

Best for: Families looking for a comfortable mountain stay with a pet-friendly atmosphere.

BUDGET | PINELAND RESORTS & CHALETS

A chalet-style resort offering a quieter and more economical mountain escape.

Chalet/resort-style accommodation.

Quieter surroundings.

Good option for travellers who want to spend more time enjoying the hills than staying in the centre of town.

Best for: Pet parents looking for a simple, peaceful and affordable Kasauli stay.

PAPERBOAT PET TIP

Kasauli isn't a place you need to conquer.

It's a place you need to walk.

Walk the pine trail.

Wander the old lanes.

Stop for a view.

Let your dog sniff every corner.

Then go back to the resort, put your feet up and watch the mountains turn golden.
